INFORMATION FOR ONLINE DELEGATES

REGISTRATION

Earlybird registration, up to and including 10th December 2021, will be \$350.
Full online registration, after 10th December, will be \$390.

When you register you will receive a login which you need to activate, and register your password. This will take you to the delegate-only page of the website.

LECTURE TIMES

- All lecture times are in Australian Central Standard Time (ACST).
- There will be half an hour between lectures, except for the hour lunch break.
- If you stay logged in, advertising slides will appear on your screen between lectures.
- Note that the Saturday and Monday program start at 9.15; the Sunday program begins at 9 am.

ZOOM LECTURES – INTERNATIONAL SPEAKERS

- Log in, then click on the lecture at the appropriate time.
- The lecture will begin with an introduction of the speaker. Sometimes the speaker stays on full screen, most likely they will begin Screen Sharing. At this point the slides appear on the screen and the speaker's head is in a small box at the side.

LIVE ONLINE LECTURES- AUSTRALIAN SPEAKERS

- Log in, then click on the lecture at the appropriate time.
- The lecture will begin with an introduction of the speaker. Once the lecture begins, you will hear the speaker but see the slides only. This is because the lecturer will be moving around.



ZOOM LECTURE ETIQUETTE

- Your microphone will be automatically muted and can only be switched on by the room moderator.
- You are welcome to leave your camera on during the presentation, however you may appear on the recording when the speaker is not sharing their screen.
- Remember that all lectures are being recorded, and if you ask a question or give personal information during a lecture, you will be part of the recording.
- Zoom chat box: You may write questions which the moderator can relay to the lecturer or, in some cases, un mute you to ask yourself.
- Do not engage in general or personal chat, as it will appear on the screen of those watching by Zoom, and it is very distracting.
- In particular, attacks against someone based on race, age, religion, politics, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation, or disability will not be tolerated. Do not comment on the personal appearance or pronouns of speakers or other attendees.
- If you wouldn't say it in a live, in-person lecture, then don't say it publicly in the chat box.

ACCESSING LECTURE RECORDINGS

Recordings will be available for 30 days after the conference. To access, log in and click on the lecture. PDFs of slides may be available.

PURCHASE OF LECTURE RECORDINGS

Recordings of individual lectures will be available for 6 months from the end of the conference for a cost of \$30. They can be purchased from this website.
